Jackson Hole, WY — Center for the Arts is proud to present **The Uncommon Art Show**, a multidisciplinary group exhibition featuring the work of past participants in the *Uncommon Art Residency*, a creative initiative that has supported artists, musicians, composers, and playwrights since its founding in 2017. The exhibit was launched by Center for the Arts in 2024 with a vision to showcase new and diverse artists that have participated in the residency.

Launched by **Erik Warner** at Sound View Greenport in New York, and expanded to The Anvil Hotel in Jackson, Wyoming, the Uncommon Art Residency offers selected artists dedicated time and space to create, explore, and share their work with the community. Over the past eight years, the residency has supported a dynamic range of contemporary creators from across the country.

With curatorial direction provided by **Kara Hoblin**, Director of the Uncommon Artist Residency at Sound View Greenport and Director of Guest Culture for The Anvil Hotel and Sound View, the exhibition will showcase small bodies of work by each artist, inviting guests into the artist's intimate creative worlds. Some of the pieces were created

or started during their residencies, offering a unique window into each artist's evolving practice. Hoblin is also the founder of the **North Fork Art Collective** in Greenport, NY, and brings years of curatorial experience to this special exhibit.

In Jackson Hole, **Travis Walker**, Director of the Uncommon Art Residency and founder of Teton ArtLab, leads the local residency program. A full-time artist himself, Walker ensures that visiting artists are immersed in the region's rich cultural and natural landscape, working within the vibrant art studios on the Center campus.
